The Rs 81,000 crore Dedicated Freight Corridor, which is the Railways' single-largest developmental project currently underway, consists of the Eastern DFC, a 1,839-km freight line from Ludhiana in Punjab to Dankuni near Kolkata, West Bengal, and the 1483-km WDFC or western

According to the DFCCIL, they had around 40,000 workers at their worksites in Uttar Pradesh and Maharashtra which primarily was reduced to around 15,000 workers during the lockdown leading to a slowdown in its work. Its managing director wrote to the states, requesting them to ensure that workers are allowed to move from the camps to the worksites, even arranging e passes for them. The agency also hired locals to supplement the workers available with them.

विलंब से चल रही हैं। रेलवे की इन दो परियोजनाओं से देश के रेल परिचालन में मूलभूत बदलाव आएगा। डीएफसी के तहत मालगाड़ियों के लिए अलग रेल-मार्ग बनाए जा रहे हैं। इसमें पूर्वी गलियारा 1,839 किलोमीटर का है जो पंजाब में लुधियाना से पश्चिम बंगाल में कोलकाता के पास दानकुनी को जोड़ेगा। पश्चिमी गलियारा दिल्ली से मुंबई के बीच विकिसित किया जा रहा है। इसकी दौड़ 1,483 किलोमीटर है। डीएफसी कॉरपोरेशन इंडिया लिमिटेड (डीएफसीसीआईएल) के नवीनतम आंकड़ों के अनुसार पूर्वी गलियारे का 60 प्रतिशत और पश्चिमी गलियारे का 56 प्रतिशत काम पूरा हो चुका है। वहीं परियोजना के लिए आवश्यक 99 प्रतिशत भूमि का अधिग्रहण कर लिया गया है। यह परियोजना दिसंबर 2021 तक पूरी होनी है। इससे भारतीय रेल को अपनी 70 प्रतिशत मालगाड़ियां इस पर स्थानांतरित करने में मदद मिलेगी। यादव ने पीटीआई-भाषा से एक साक्षात्कार में कहा, '' डीएफसीसीआईएल का अपने श्रमिकों को निर्माण स्थलों के पास शिविरों में रखने का निर्णय बहुत अच्छा है। वहां उन्हें मूलभूत सुविधाएं दी जा रही हैं जिसकी वजह से बड़ी संख्या में मजदूर अपने घरों को वापस नहीं गए हैं। इस वजह से काम रुका नहीं, बस थोड़ा धीमा हुआ है। वैसे भी अभी इसकी समयसीमा पूरा होने में काफी समय है।'' डीएफसीसीआईएल के अनुसार उत्तरप्रदेश एवं महाराष्ट्र में उसके विभिन्न निर्माण स्थलों पर करीब 40,000 श्रमिक हैं जो अभी घटकर

# बुलेट ट्रेन, डीएफसीला कोरोनाचा फटका नाही

## दोन्ही प्रकल्प वेळेतच पूर्ण होणार असल्याचा रेल्वेचा दावा

ा नवी दिल्ली : भारतीय रेल्वेच्या आधुनिकीकरणातील मैलाचा दगड ठरणारे डीएफसी अर्थात मालगाड्यांसाठीचा विशेष कॉरिडॉर आणि बुलेट ट्रेन हे दोन महत्त्वाकांक्षी प्रकल्प कोणत्याही विलंबाविना वेळेतच पूर्ण होतील, असा दावा रेल्वे बोर्डाचे अध्यक्ष व्ही. के. यादव यांनी केला. लॉकडाऊनमुळे रेल्वेला मोठा आर्थिक फटका बसलेला असल्यामुळे यादव यांचे वक्तव्य विशेष महत्त्वाचे आहे.

मुंबई-अहमदाबाद बुलेट ट्रेन हा मोदी सरकारचा महत्त्वाकांक्षी प्रकल्प आहे. २०२३ पर्यंत देशातील पहिली बुलेट ट्रेन सुरू करण्याचे सरकारचे नियोजन आहे. महाराष्ट्रात सत्तांतर झाल्यानंतर या प्रकल्पावर अनिश्चिततेचे सावट पसरले होते. ठाकरे सरकार या प्रकल्पातून माघार घेणार असल्याची चर्चा होती. या प्रकल्पाची व्यवहार्यतादेखील तपासण्यात येणार होती. त्यातच लॉकडाऊनमुळे राज्याची आर्थिक परिस्थिती कमकुवत झाल्याने या बुलेट ट्रेनसाठीच्या खर्चातील महाराष्ट्राच्या वाट्याचा आर्थिक भार पेलण्यास राज्य सरकार तयार नसल्याचे सांगण्यात येत होते. त्यामुळे हा प्रकल्प वेळेत पूर्ण होणार की नाही, याबद्दल अनिश्चितता निर्माण झाली आहे; परंतु रेल्वे

बोर्डाच्या अध्यक्षांनुसार हा प्रकल्प वेळेत पूर्ण होईल. बुलेट ट्रेनचे प्रत्यक्ष काम सुरू झाले नसले तरी कामासाठीच्या निविदा देणे आणि भूसंपादनाची प्रक्रिया सुरू असल्याचे यादव यांनी सांगितले. मालवाहतुकीसाठीचा विशेष कॉरिडॉर अर्थात डीएफसी हा रेल्वेचा दुसरा मोठा प्रकल्प आहे. लॉकडाऊनच्या काळात डीएफसीच्या कंत्राटदारांनी कामगारांना कामाच्या ठिकाणीच राहण्याची आणि अन्नपाण्याची सोय उपलब्ध करून दिली. त्यामुळे इतर प्रकल्पांमधील स्थलांतरित मजूर गावी गेले असले तरी या प्रकल्पाचे कामगार कार्यरत होते. प्रकल्पाचे काम थांबले नसल्यामुळे तो वेळेत पूर्ण होईल, असे यादव म्हणाले. डीएफसी प्रकल्प ८१ हजार कोटी रुपयांचा आहे. याचे पूर्व आणि पश्चिम डीएफसी, असे दोन भाग आहेत. पूर्व डीएफसीचे ६० टक्के तर पश्चिम डीएफसीचे सुमारे ५६ टक्के काम पूर्ण झाले आहे. या प्रकल्पासाठीचे ९९ टक्के भूसंपादन झाले असून, २०२१ पर्यंत तो पूर्ण करण्याचे नियोजन आहे. हा कॉरिडॉर तयार झाल्यानंतर रेल्वेमार्गावरील ७० टक्के मालवाहतूक या मार्गावरून होईल आणि इतर रेल्वेमार्ग प्रवासी गाड्यांसाठी मोकळे होतील.
