

MG Contractors lowest bidder for construction of MAHSR bridges

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CONSTRUCTION AND REAL estate company MG Contractors has emerged as the lowest bidder for construction of 5 special bridges between Vadodara and Ahmedabad, part of Mumbai-Ahmedabad High Speed Rail Corridor project. Three companies, including MG Contractors, had bid for the project.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi and his former Japanese counterpart Shinzo Abe, had on September 14, 2017 laid the foundation stone for the ₹1.08 lakh crore project.

The financial bids for the project were opened on Tuesday by the National High Speed Rail Corporation for construction of 5 special bridges, including 1 Prestressed concrete bridge, and erection of 4 steel truss bridges between Vadodara and Ahmedabad.

On Monday, MG Contractors emerged as the lowest bidder for another MAHSR project involving construction of 11 rail bridges in the package MAHSR-P-1(B).
