The GSTIN Certificate of the Bidder purchasing the Bidding document shall be submitted at the time of purchase of the Bidding documents.

4. In case the bidder is registered as a vendor under the category of Micro, Small and Medium enterprises (MSME), he must state his Udyog Aadhar Memorandum (UAM) number. The onus of proving that the bidder is exempted from payment of cost of tender document and/or EMD lies on the bidder. It should be noted that mere opening of bid does not mean that the bid has to be considered by NHSRCL as a valid bid. If later, it is discovered from the submitted documents that bidder is not exempted from payment of cost of tender and/or EMD, his bid shall be treated as non-responsive and is liable to be rejected summarily.

Extension of time for submission of PG beyond 28 (Twenty Eight) days and upto 60 days from the date of issue of LOA may be given by the Authority who is competent to sign the contract agreement. However, a penal interest of 12% per annum shall be charged for the delay beyond 28 (Twenty Eight) days, i.e. from 29th day after the date of issue of LOA. In case the contractor fails to submit the requisite PG even after 60 days from the date of issue of LOA, the contract shall be terminated duly forfeiting EMD and other dues, if any payable against that contract.
